

- **PITCHING**

Tents and caravans should be 3m. apart and groups 6m apart.

- **DRINKING WATER**

All cold water taps are on the mains so all can be used for drinking water. There is a tap in the first field behind the wall.

- **NOISE**

Keep the noise level low. **Children after 8pm** to stay close to own tent and no running around or shouting,

After 10pm. everyone to be of no disturbance to others so that others can sleep if they so wish. No music. **Absolute quiet after 12.00pm.**

If you are an early riser please be considerate of those who wish to sleep in.

- **DOGS**

Keep your dogs on a lead at all times and ensure any mess is cleared up immediately.

- **SPEED**

5 mph

- **VISITORS**

Welcome during the day.

Charge - £5.00/car, £2.00/bike

- **BBQ**

You can use a BBQ if it is stable and positioned so that the grass does not get scorched (Bricks can be found by the gate in the main field and by the tower on the lawns, fire blankets supplied with the braziers).

- **BRAZIER HIRE**

If you would like to hire a brazier and/or buy wood could you please collect it from us by 7.30pm.

Ensure it is positioned on flat ground and stable

- **Fires are to be out by 11.45 pm**

Safety Using the Brazier/BBQ sign - on the brown door by the showers it must be read before starting your fire.

- **CARBON MONOXIDE**

Do not take BBQ's or fires into your tent or porch, the fumes can kill. Even a warm BBQ can be lethal.

- **SHOWERS & HOT WATER**

Hot water may go cold with frequent use. The heating system takes approximately 20 mins. to reheat

Showers are unisex so please change in the cubicles and not outside them.

Boxes are provided in the showers to keep your clothes dry thus no hooks. Please leave dirty shoes outside of the showers in the boxes/rack provided.

- **RUBBISH**

Please recycle your rubbish

Separate all of your cans, glass, plastic and paper and put them in the appropriate recycling bins by the side of the toilets.

- We do not accept responsibility for the **security** of your vehicle or belongings whilst on site. We have a safe lock-up for mountain bikes, please see us and we will lock them away for you.

- **HYGEINE**

Please remember you are camping on a working farm, read the notice in the toilets and remember if you are handling wood some of it may have been sourced off the farm.

- **STREAM**

Enter the stream at your own risk
Supervise children at all times
Check for current, depth, rocks and Obstructions.
